



Operator Scholarship Application Helpful Tips:

- Make sure your WEF membership is up to date.
- Fill out each section of your application that has a point value associated with it. See [FAQ](#) for how the application is reviewed.
- Provide a clear and accurate breakdown of the “Cost Documentation,” please don’t only provide a link to a website with no additional information. The clearer you can make this, the easier it is for application reviewers to follow, which will be reflected in a better score. See the [FAQ](#) for examples of a Cost Documentation if you are unsure.
- Make sure the “Amount Requested” is reflected accurately in your “Cost Documentation.”
- Your “Funding Request” should be about what you are requesting funds for and how what you are requesting funds for will benefit your career in water.
- Your “Essay” should clearly answer one of the following three prompts:
 - A. Why did you select this career?;
 - B. How do you want to contribute to the field/industry?; or,
 - C. What are your career goals?
- Additional information can be your resume, certification list, additional information about the fund request, etc. It is a good idea to upload at least a resume here as there is a point value associated with this section.
- Have someone proofread your application, a second set of eyes is always helpful.
